Scoring Criteria

Writing

Written evidence **may identify** materials, processes, and ideas.

3-D Art and Design Skills

Little to no visual evidence of 3-D **skills**.

Materials, Processes, and Ideas

Little to no evidence of **visual relationships** among materials, processes, or ideas.

Score Rationale

The written evidence identifies some information about materials, processes, and ideas but does little to enhance the understanding and intention of compositional pursuit.

The selected works demonstrate little or no 3-D design skills (elements and principals) application. The works are primarily compositions that lack activation of surrounding space and tend to rely on a closed form (Work 1). To achieve a score of 2, each sculpture could be developed further by addressing aspects of shape, texture, and visual balance. Overall, the portfolio displays little to no understanding of 3-D skills.

The simplistic and understated descriptions in the written evidence provide little to no evidence of visual relationships among materials, processes, and ideas. Ideation development and process exploration are needed to strengthen visual relationships.
